#### Camp Program Overview:

Join us at this year's Day Camp for "Oceans of Fun." Some of the exciting activities planned are Archery, Swimming, Sports, Nature, Arts and Crafts, Scout Skills, and, not to mention, our plans to just have FUN!!! *Day Camp is a fun-filled week of challenging Cub Scout activities, confidence building, exciting adventures and new friendships.*

Camper arrival is between 7:45am and 8:00am. Camp Aides, Den Leaders and Staff are to be at camp at 7:30am, and will depart at 4:30pm.

**\*\* Applications, excluding Tigers, received after the June 1, 2008 deadline will be accepted on a space-available basis only. Tiger applications will be accepted until June 13, 2008.**

Camp fees include a camp T-shirt, snack each day, an event patch and provides for the use of our camp facilities, special program guests, event and program equipment.

#### Camp Location:

Camp will be held at the Aycock Elementary School in Vance County, which is off Hwy 39 from Route 1. The address is 305 Carey Chapel Road, Henderson, North Carolina 27537.

#### Eligibility and Transportation:

To participate in Cub Scout Day Camp, a boy must be registered with a Cub Scout Pack. This includes boys who are just beginning as Tiger Cubs (as of June 1). No person or groups will be excluded because of race, color, national origin, or hardship for participation in Cub Scout Day Camp. Transportation to and from camp is the parent's responsibility.

#### Camp Uniform:

Each camp participant is required to wear an official camp T-shirt everyday with BSA shorts/pants and tennis shoes. No open-toed shoes will be allowed. Each camper will need to bring swimming trunks, sandals or water shoes, and a towel. You may bring your own life jacket and goggles if you wish.

#### Medication:

Each attendee must bring any medication, including inhalers and epipens, which need to be given at camp. Upon arrival at camp, all medications will be turned into the camp nurse. Minor children will transport no medications.

#### Lunches, Snacks and Drinks:

Each Camp Attendee, Volunteer, Den Leader and Staff Member is responsible for providing his or her own non-perishable lunch and drink everyday. It is advised that each camper put their healthy lunch inside of a labeled, one gallon zip lock baggie with a frozen drink inside to help keep their lunch cool. The camp will provide snacks, lemonade and water each day.

#### Family Fun Day:

Family Fun Day will be held on Friday beginning at 2:00pm. This event will include refreshments and will conclude with our awards ceremony. Parents and siblings are encouraged to attend. Day Camp will provide the drinks and cool-off refreshments. Family afternoon will be over at 4:00pm.

#### Kids Korral:

The "Kids Korral" provides a Day Camp experience with activities for young children of Staff members, Den Leaders and parent volunteers. In order for a child to attend Kids Korral, a parent **MUST** be in camp while they attend. We do not provide day care for Scout siblings. In addition, each attendee must be toilet trained or other arrangements made.

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**Tiger Program:**

Our camp has an exciting program for incoming Tiger Cubs in order to introduce them to the fun of both Cub Scout Day Camp and Scouting. Tigers are invited to attend the full week's program of camp activities. Any incoming Tiger who registers for camp needs to have an adult partner accompany them every day. Incoming Tigers must also complete a BSA Cub Scout registration form. Contact your local Pack or call Occoneechee Council (919) 872-4884.

**Volunteers:**

Our camp is staffed with volunteers and without adequate parental assistance our camp could not function. No experience is necessary and there are a wide variety of positions that need to be filled. Volunteering your time, even if its just one day, will allow you to reap the benefits of a great program and have fun with an awesome group of boys. Come join the fun and excitement! To find out about volunteer opportunities available, please contact the Camp Director.

**Camp Aides:**

Boy Scouts of any age & older siblings, who are at least 14 years of age, are invited to volunteer as Camp Aides. Service hours will be recorded and a letter providing proof of service will be given at the end of each camp session. If an adult attends camp on Staff for the week, older siblings, between the ages of 11 and 14 years may also assist their parent as a Camp Aide.

**Den Leaders, Volunteers and Staff Members:**

All camp Den Leaders, Volunteers and Staff Members are required to attend a Camp Leader training session prior to camp. The time and location will be announced at a later date. This training is mandatory for our national standards and accreditation. In addition, each adult must also have taken **Youth Protection Training**. Youth Protection Training may be taken online at [www.scouting.org](http://www.scouting.org) or in a classroom setting (check the Occoneechee Council web site at [www.campdurant.com](http://www.campdurant.com) for a training schedule). For descriptions of the Den Leader or Staff Member responsibilities please review the "Great Northern District Cub Scout Day Camp Volunteer Manual".

**Registration, Camper-ships and Refunds:**

Anyone interested in attending camp must submit a complete registration form and health form. Fees must also be paid in full with the completed registration form. Full and partial camper-ships are available for families with financial hardships. Please contact the Camp Director for more information about financial assistance. ## Behavior Contract

*While we recognize that children need discipline at some point and time, a Scout who consistently requires disciplinary action creates an environment that is not enjoyable and potentially unsafe for himself and others.
